

BY-LAW NO. 108-2000

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2705-80, BEING A
BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT AND REGULATE THE PLACING
OR ERECTION OF SIGNS, NOTICES, AND ADVERTISING
DEVICES WITHIN OR ADJACENT TO REGIONAL ROADS
WITH RESPECT TO ELECTION SIGNS

WHEREAS it is desirable to create consistency and conformity for rules and regulations governing the placement of election signs on public property within Niagara's area municipalities.

THEREFORE the Council of The Regional Municipality of Niagara enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 3.3.1. (c) of By-law 2705-80 where by-laws enacted by area municipalities governing the placing, or prohibition of placing, election signs on public property, the provisions of any by-law of such area municipality will apply to Regional road allowances in that area municipality.
2. Where the by-law of an area municipality noted in Section 1 of this by-law is applicable, responsibility for enforcement of the provisions of that area municipality's by-law and all costs associated therewith will be the responsibility of such area municipality.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the day upon which it is passed.
