BY-LAW NO. 61-2010

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 56-2009,
BEING A BY-LAW TO DEFINE THE PURCHASING POLICIES AND
PROCEDURES FOR THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF NIAGARA

WHEREAS the Regional Council of The Regional Municipality of Niagara has passed By-law No. 56-2009 to define the purchasing policies and procedures for the Regional Municipality of Niagara; and

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend By-law 56-2009 to extend the Purchasing Authorities and Document Execution Authorities set out in Schedule "D" (Appendix A to this By-law) to December 31, 2010.

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF NIAGARA ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Subsection 3 (e) of the Purchasing By-Law No. 56-2009 be repealed and replaced with the following:

"From the date this By-law comes into force until December 31, 2010, the Purchasing Authorities and Document Execution Authorities set out in Schedule "D" (Appendix A to this By-law) shall apply to all purchases of Goods and Services by the Public Works Department of the Corporation; and"
2. That Subsection 3 (f) of the Purchasing By-Law No. 56-2009 be repealed and replaced with the following:

"Despite Subsection 3 (e), the Purchasing Authorities and Document Execution Authorities set out in Schedule "D" (Appendix A to this By-law) shall continue to apply to all purchasing processes commenced by the Public Works Department before December 31, 2010."
3. That in all other respects the said By-law 56-2009 shall remain in full force and effect.

4. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date upon which it is passed.
