Ontario Early Years Child and Family Centres Business Practices and Funding

Guidelines for Service System Managers (2018)

Intent: To outline Children's Services policies and practices regarding Indigenous-led

licensed child care and early years programs and service in Niagara.

Rationale: To comply with Ontario Ministry of Education requirements and expectations

regarding Indigenous-led licensed child care and early years programs and

services.

Niagara Region Children's Services, as the Consolidated Municipal Services Manager (CMSM) is required to offer programs and services that reflect local Indigenous cultures, as determined through local service planning and engagement with parents and caregivers. The CMSM is expected to work in close partnership with Indigenous organizations and local First Nation (if applicable) to plan for and deliver culturally response early years programs and

services off-reserve.

Definitions: Content not required.

Policy: Niagara Region Children's Services works with service providers to ensure

service levels for Indigenous off-reserve licensed child care programs are maintained since the transfer of responsibility from the province to the local

municipality in 1999.

Scope: This policy is specific to licensed child care and early years programs and

services for children under age twelve and their parents and/or caregivers. It is not intended to address early years services funded by the federal government.

Procedure:

1. Children's Services enter into a contract with all Indigenous licensed child care centres and family resource centres.

- 2. These non-profit organizations must comply with all additional regional requirements.
- 3. CMSM's are expected to engage Indigenous partners on an ongoing basis as part of local planning for the early years.
