

Materials

- Egg cartons
- Paper, felt, or foam
- Crayons, markers or paint
- White glue or hot glue
- Scissors

Step 6



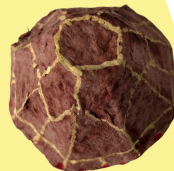
Glue your arms and legs

Step 1



Cut out one section of your egg carton. Make sure bottom is flat.

Step 2



Paint or colour your egg carton. This is the turtle's shell

Step 5



Stick head and tail to opposite sides

Step 4



Put glue on the flap marked "glue" and stick to inside of shell

Step 3



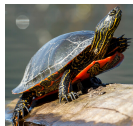
Print off and colour your turtle's head, arms, legs, and tail. Or trace onto coloured paper, felt or foam.

REAL TURTLE PAINTING TIPS

Eastern Painted Turtle



- Red spots along sides of shell
- Red lines on arms and legs
- Bright yellow lines along face

Blanding's Turtle

- Yellow throat
- Small yellow spots on shell
- Always look like they are smiling :)



Northern Map Turtle



- Yellow lines along face, arms and legs
- Super cool swirls on shell (they are called a map turtle because these swirls look like map contour lines)

Spotted Turtle

- Large, bright yellow spots on shell
- Yellow spots on arms and legs
