Re-Alignment of Regional Road 14 (Smithville Road) And Replacement of Existing Mill Creek Bridge (Structure No. 014210) Between South Chippawa Road and Concession Road No. 2 Township of West Lincoln

Sealed tenders, plainly marked as to contents, will be received by the Niagara Region Corporate Services, 1815 Sir Isaac Brock Way, Thorold, Ontario, until 2:00 p.m. local time on **Tuesday, June 5, 2018.**

The work to be carried out under this contract consists of, but is not limited to:

- 16,000m³ of excavation
- 8,500 tonnes of granular materials
- 2,500 tonnes of hot mix asphalt
- 15,300m² of topsoil and seed
- House demolition
- Remove and replace bridge

This contract utilizes the "**Niagara Peninsula Standard Contract Document (Revision 19)**" which forms the specification documents excepting the "Special Instruction to Bidders, Form of Tender and Supplementary Special Provisions". The "Standard Document" is available on the internet at the "Bid Opportunities" section of the Niagara Region website www.niagararegion.ca.
