3. Business Arising from previous meeting:

- Group discussion on Recycling

- Committee member references recent City of Toronto news regarding inability to recycle black plastic
- Recycle Centre with new equipment, i.e. Optical Sorter is able to separate out contaminants
- Niagara Recycling has implemented new equipment to try minimize contamination of its end products allowing them to find markets.
- Tim Horton's recycling bins were discussed, the bins have sections to separate recycling.

Staff Request: Look into Recycle Plastic article in next issue of Green Scene

4. Update on Projects

a) New Cell Development

- Consultant has been retained
- Tender out week of March 26 closing end of April
- Construction to start May
- 2 phase construction to ensure enough waste available to prevent freezing
 - 2018 South side
 - 2019 remainder

b) Pump Station Upgrade

- Design completed
- Delay in work to avoid multiple projects going at same time
- MOECC 3-6 months for response

c) Drop off Depot

- Looking into modifying Drop off Depot to accommodate Tractor Trailer pickup, i.e. Electronics, Mattresses etc
- Project postponed to 2019

d) Ponds size evaluation at Niagara Road 12 and Mountain Road landfill

- Pond size is based on 25 year storm MOECC request to increase size to accommodate 100 year storm
- Application back from MOECC
- Anticipate Fall to start project
- Arrange timing with contractors of other projects at the site

e) Compost Giveaway

- Previous seasons proved bagging was successful
- Cash donations doubled
- Food donations increased 20%

- Will continue bagging for 2018 Spring season

f) Re-use Centre at Niagara Road 12

- November 10, 2017 opened
- Well received, great compliments
- GBF happy with donations, quality and volume, compliments there current operation
- Committee member advises GBF to track sales of merchandise coming from the Re-use Centre
- Traffic will increase as awareness spreads
- What 1 car brings in to Re-use centre is equivalent to 3 car loads going to the store
- Discussion on bottle collection
 - Possibility of donating to West Lincoln Community Care and Grimsby Benevolent Fund for the proceeds

g) New Legislation (Bill 151)

- Changing recycle industry
- Making manufacturers responsible for disposal
- Implementation still unclear

h) Update Humberstone EA

- EA Submitted to MOECC
- Anticipate will receive application in 6 months
- Will allow site 25-30 years
- Footprint will not change, saddle shaped to reduce visual to surrounding neighbourhood

5. Other Business

• **Landfill Sign on Concession 7**

- Member recommended sign to include "Re-Use Centre"

• **Illegal Dumping**

- Discussion on conviction by the Ministry of Natural Resources regarding a house burned and bull dozed into Lake Ontario (June 6, 2016)
- Waste Management's Illegal dumping group has teamed up with Crime Stoppers and have paid several rewards from convictions

• **Operations Contract**

- Current contract for NR12 ends September
- Starting to evaluate bids

- 5 year contract and option with 2 year extension
- **Emterra Issues**
 - Collection issues have improved
