**BUSINESS ARISING FROM MINUTES**

Business Arising from Previous Minutes

- i) Update on Drainage:  
Staff reported on his meeting with the neighbor regarding his water drainage issue. They walked through the bush together where the farmer raised concerns about the dying trees and water drainage in the bush. The farmer also raised the issue of the culvert crossing Mud Street. Region's Transportation Division resurveyed the area in question and checked their drawings. They confirmed that is was

built to spec. The Drainage Supervisors for Grimsby and West Lincoln were also contacted. The other side of Mud Road wasn't cleaned due to the Town's budget limitations. The Region has arranged to complete this work. The drainage supervisors believed that once both sides are cleaned the issue should be resolved.

Staff called in a consultant to inspect the trees on the landfill property and the neighbour's property. He will submit a written report of his findings. What he observed is nothing out of the ordinary for the region.

NPCA was also contacted and stated that the area is a provincially significant wetland, therefore no drainage can be changed and they will provide a written report.

Surveyors at Concession 7 looked at the topographic fall, to see if there is anything identifiable and noted that because it's flat, not much to be done.

The Region has received a letter from the Federation of Agriculture sent on behalf of the neighbor. There will now be formal follow up to the neighbour.

The Committee thanked staff for their effort.

Update on force main: Staff did an inspection, no manholes were found open. Staff are patrolling periodically to check.

Recycling of plastic wrap and baler twine – no new information from Clean All Farms.

### **ITEMS FOR INFORMATION**

1. Annual Monitoring and Operations Reports were distributed to the members present for review and discussion at next meeting.

Councillor Thompson requested electronic copies emailed to him.

Copies will be mailed to absent councillor members.

2. Tender – Operation of Landfill  
Current contract expires end of this year, December 1. A tender will be released soon, for a 5.5 yr. contract.

Operational contract: all operations but the scale house staff is contracted. Landfilling, composting, clean up and staffing. All Regional landfill sites are under operations contracts.

Committee member inquired if the committee could review and comment on the tender before it is issued.

Staff can distribute a copy of the tender upon request and any comments will be taken under consideration for the next tender.

3. Site Upgrades  
The site is being repaved and cleaned around the container stations. The curbs will be replaced in front of the bins.
4. Weed Cutting  
The work was already scheduled when the issue was called in, and was completed.

### **OTHER BUSINESS**

Work on the 40 Mile Creek Bridge (Johnson drain leads to this.) is just for the decking of the bridge.
