NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE #2 MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR: LIVINGSTON AVENUE EXTENSION (RR512) WEST OF EMILY STREET TO MAIN STREET (RR81)

PURPOSE OF THE STUDY

The Regional Municipality of Niagara (Niagara Region) is completing a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) for the extension of Livingston Avenue west of Emily Street to Main Street, in the Town of Grimsby.

The purpose of the study is to examine the need and opportunities for providing additional east-west travel capacity in west Grimsby and consider alternative ways to achieve this, including an extension of Livingston Avenue, intersection improvements and new infrastructure to facilitate walking and cycling.

- A review of the project need and opportunities
- A review of the background studies completed to date
- A review of the preliminary alternative concepts evaluation results for improving east-west connectivity through the study area

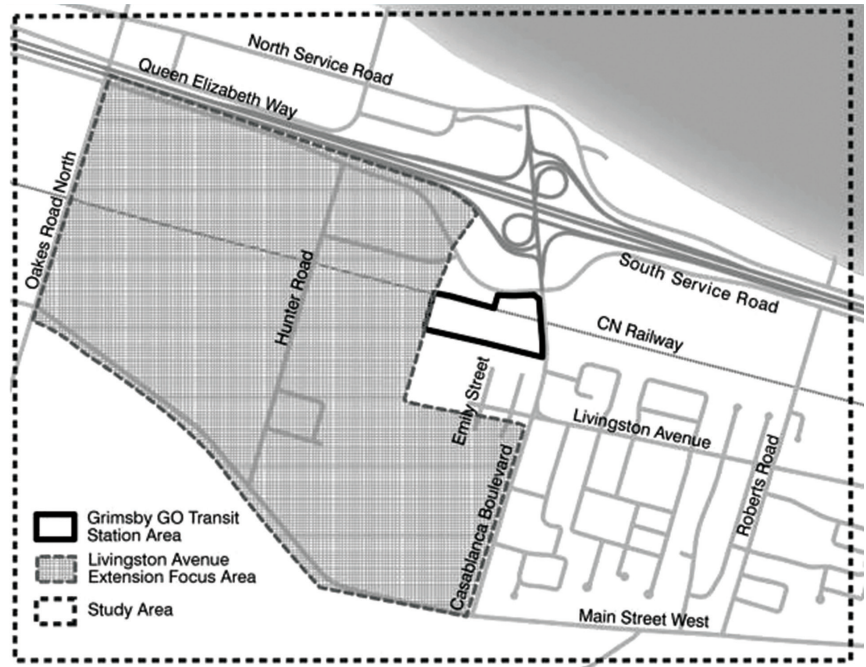
The project team will review and consider the comments received at PIC#2, and collect feedback to be carried forward in considering the alternative designs for the preferred concept.
